**Subject: Non-fitment of High Security Registration Plates on vehicles registered in the State of Rajasthan before July 2012 and in the period of 01-09-2017 to 31-03-2019: regarding.**

Sir,

This is to bring in the notice of all motor vehicles enforcement agencies of your State that the matter of affixation and supply of High Security Registration Plate (HSRP) on old vehicles in the State of Rajasthan, is subjudiced in Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court, Jaipur. Because of pendency of the litigation, Rajasthan Government could not have opted out any of the alternative prescribed in Rule 50 of CMVR i.e. supply and fitment of HSRP on old vehicles by dealers of the manufactures or by a vendor selected through bidding process. Since 1 April 2019 newly registered vehicles are being affixed with HSRP delivered by manufactures and fitted at dealer point.

Some vehicle owners have represented to this office that they are harassed and challaned by enforcement authorities while visiting in certain States. They are challaned for carrying ordinary number plate on their vehicles, as these are not affixed with HSRP.

In the backdrop of above series of events it is just not possible to adopt any mechanism to get the HSRP fitted on vehicle registered prior to July 2012 and registered between 01-09-2017 to 31-03-2019 (in this period, there was no facility available owing to litigation). Kindly convey instructions to the vehicle checking agencies of your state not to book offences against the vehicles of Rajasthan State registered in the said span of time for violation of carrying improper registration number plates.
